

Walk inky / painted fingers around a piece of paper.



Blow bubbles and pinch to pop. Use the left and the right hand.

Draw around 2D shapes and then cut out.



Hook paper clips to several pieces of card.

Line up dominoes in lines of 3 and 5, knock them down and stand them back up.



Pick up objects using large tweezers such as small cubes or counters.

Mould and roll playdough into balls - using the palms of the hands facing each other and with fingers curled slightly towards the palm.



Use toothpicks to make designs in play dough.

Pop bubble wrap. Squeeze with thumb and forefinger. Use your left and right hand.



Roll playdough into tiny balls (pea size) using only the finger tips. Use your left and right hand.

Cut playdough with a plastic knife or with a pizza wheel by holding the implement in a diagonal volar grasp.



Tear newspaper into strips and then crumpling them into balls. Use to stuff scarecrow or other art creation.

Scrunch up 1 sheet of newspaper in one hand. This is a super strength builder. Use your left and right hand.



Use a plant sprayer to spray plants (indoors, outdoors).

(mix food coloring with water so that the snow can be painted)



Turn over cards, without bringing them to the edge of the table.

Shake dice by cupping the hands together, forming an empty air space between the palms.

Make pictures using stickers or self-sticking paper reinforcements.
